

Introduction to the Intellix Solution Framework

Overview

This course presents the Intellix Solution Framework (ISF) for a wide audience ranging from administrators to developers and consultants. The first part presents the benefits of ISF from various points of view, i.e. value added to business processes, to deployment platforms, and advantages for the build and maintenance of solutions. Also included is an outline of the ISF architecture and a description of predominant subsystems. In the second part examples of Knowledge Solutions making use of the ISF are presented. These examples demonstrate how to use ISF to optimise solutions with respect to performance, scalability and reliability.
