

Knowledge Mapping with the Intellix Designer

Overview

This course is the entry point to the world of Intellix technology and Intellix Solutions. It gives a jump start with Intellix' key concepts, including neural networks, knowledge engineering and the many sources of knowledge. It then moves on to an intensive walkthrough of the features of the Intellix Designer and uses a series of hands-on exercises to secure that all the basic skills are learned well. These exercises are interwoven with the teaching of how to conduct the knowledge mapping process, using a single development case, the Intellix Mini-Bank, as a golden thread. Consultants and business experts will after this course be able to develop knowledge domains on their own and thereby be able to capture essential business process knowledge for their company and make it operational and available throughout the entire organisation. The course has a pragmatic focus and puts emphasis on the hands-on experience and on problem solving.
